Task 5.1 Prioritization, development and update of PRIMA objectives, Task leader MIUR

Prioritization to be made on the 8 PRIMA operational goals :

- 1. Smart and sustainable farming;
- 2. Water-saving solution;
- 3. Nutrition/Mediterranean diet;
- 4. Food and Water chain efficiency;
- 5. Reduction of impact of pest and pathogens in farming;
- 6. Innovative business models in agri-food industry;
- 7. Land and water sustainability in arid and semi-arid watersheds;
- 8. Policies and governance of water management systems
- Consultation mainly at PRIMA Participating Countries level, taking into account PRIMA indicators for monitoring based on SDGs, made via workshop and surveying (policy makers, industries, public/private utilities)
- Preparation of a document summarising an extended list of priorities









Task 5.2 Preparation of SRIA Consultation and Consultation on SRIA White Paper, Task leader MINECO

- To elaborate the needed questionnaires and papers for the consultation (On-line and off-line documents will be used).
- To involve the 4PRIMA External Advisory Board (EAB) and the relevant stakeholders mapped in Task 5.1 to gather the relevant agenda driving forces scientific/ technological output, trends, needs, gaps and priorities. Physical and on-line meetings with the EAB will be used to structure the views from the individual board members.





Task 5.3 Elaboration of SRIA, Task leader ANR

- Implement and elaborate the results of the consultations of expert and stakeholders,
- The prioritization of need and gaps, setting the definitive contents of the SRIA,
- Adjusting priorities and considering which are the most suitable type of actions to be implemented in each items (projects, mobility) for the benefit of the broader Euro-Mediterranean research and innovation community.
- The SRIA will summarize major scientific aspects and milestones, calls and coordination needs within EU and non EU programmes.
- SRIA will be reviewed by the Executive Board and PRIMA members and approved by the Steering Committee.





Task 5.4 Guidelines for transferring contents from research agendas to national policies and Research institutions, Task leader MESRST.

- Aimed at ensuring the creation of the framework conditions for reinforced cooperation and coordination of food systems and water research programmes within a long term partnership involving research funding bodies, universities, ministries or any other stakeholders from the two sides of the Mediterranean area
- This will be instrumental to enabling the conditions for a future implementation of those legislative and funding instruments that govern the relationship between the European Union and Members (non-EU) and are needed in order to achieve the expected impact of 4PRIMA.
- Deliver a document containing guidelines and advices for the national and international political institutions in order to facilitate the uptake of the PRIMA SRIA and their future implementation
