I would like to thank you for sending me the proposal of the PRIMA joint programme. Let me also express my appreciation for the good work carried out by the Italian Presidency under your leadership that has resulted in the adoption of Council Conclusions on PRIMA in December.

As the Council Conclusions indicate, stability, prosperity and a sustainable economic development and job creation in partner countries of the Southern Mediterranean are of mutual benefit. I am convinced that through research and innovation we can promote these developments and fully grasp the potential of "science diplomacy" to deliver critical solutions on food and water issues for the region.

Against this background and considering the political importance of the issues at stake, I decided to immediately set the wheels in motion and launch concrete actions in order to lay the foundations for this renewed research and innovation partnership with the Southern Mediterranean countries.

First, I asked my services to initiate an Article 185 procedure based on the PRIMA proposal. Second, and in parallel, I will explore the possibility of a European Joint Programming cofund action in the Horizon 2020 Work Programme 2016-2017.

To ensure sustained success, as underlined by you at the recent Palermo Ministerial conference, it is critical from the outset to fully involve the Agriculture Ministers of the Mediterranean countries and their research bodies and initiatives.

By building this initiative on solid foundations, I believe that we will be in a position to enhance our research and innovation cooperation on food and water issues, as a visible deliverable to the forthcoming revision of the European Neighbourhood Policy. I am confident that you will also support an enhanced role for research and innovation in this context.
