Joint Programming

- Concept: Endorsed by Council of the EU in 2008 to support the formation of the European Research Area
- Rationale: Address major societal (global) challenges that cannot be solved solely on the national level in a coordinated way
- Method: Via the alignent of national research programmes and activities across participating countries
- A JPI is **not** an integrated European joint programme
- It is an intergovernmental initiative that aims to improve research coordination





Alignment

"Alignment is the strategic approach taken by Member States to **modify** their national [research] programmes, priorities or activities as a consequence of the adoption of **joint research priorities** in the context of Joint Programming, with a view to improving the efficiency of investment in research at the level of Member-States and the European Research Area"

(High-Level Joint Programming Group, European Research Area Committee)

Main goals:

- ✓ Optimally use existing national research funds
- ✓ Address societal challenges more effectively
- ✓ Structure & strengthen the European Research Area






JPI on Agriculture, Food Security and Climate Change: Key Facts

- **Participants**: 21 EU/Associated Member-Countries; 1 Associate-Member (New Zealand); 2 observers (EC, EU Standing Committee on Agricultural Research)
- Start: Launched by EC Council in 2010
- Secretariat: Staff from 8 countries; coordinated by INRA (France), financially supported by the EC (CSA1, 2011-14; CSA, 2015-20)
- Key principles:
 - Alignment of national research strategies, programmes, infrastructures in a specific field
 - Variable geometry








FACCE JPI's thematic scope






From a common strategic research agenda to joint research actions: A four stage process

FACCE-JPI Implementation Plans: 3 types of joint actions

- Actions that allow to align already funded research at national levels
 - Knowledge Hubs => Member-States' funding
 - Knowledge Network => Member-States' funding
 - ➤ Thematic Annual Programming Network => Member-States' funding
- Actions that allow to invest jointly in new transnational research
 - FACCE-JPI ERA-NETs => Member States + EC co-funding (Horizon2020)
 - > Joint calls for research proposals (some with international partners)
 - => Member-States' funding
- Actions that allow to explore emerging joint research areas
 - Exploratory workshops => Member-States' funding



Links with 4PRIMA

"Food systems and water resources for the development of inclusive, sustainable and healthy Euro-Mediterranean societies" (H2020 SC5)

- FACCE-JPI members agreed to support the 4PRIMA CSA (endorsement letter, Jan. 2016)
- Objective: Promote information-sharing, coordination, complementarity
- Rationale:
- ✓ Similar thematic focus
- ✓ Overlap in membership (e.g., France, Spain, Italy)
- ✓ Better link between agricultural research and agricultural research for development *within* our members
- ✓ Greater visibility for FACCE-JPI internationally
